...and so on. I won't tell you that Google is your friend because, in your case, it is not, as they have an agreement with the party. :-(

You might also find it useful to know how to post in Usenet through NNTP servers that hide the information, such as news.aioe.org using the standard NNTP port. For more free news servers try <news:alt.free.newsservers> for example. There are quite a few, although some will charge a minimal initial setup fee

You might also find it immensely helpful to use secure tunnelling, and this is a good group in which to enquire... ..but key loggers? I can see that they may have an ethical application... ..maybe.

Anyhow, always be careful, especially if you have a government that is nominally communist or extremely right wing. Stay alive.
