I would like to call 'shutdown immediate' in my proc program but I could not figure how to do it. Tried calling it using EXEC SQL but it failed with
"ORA-00900: invalid SQL statement".

You cannot do this with embedded SQL.

SHUTDOWN is not an SQL command, it is an SQL*Plus command.

To shutdown an Oracle database from C, use the OCI interface.
