I use Accuterm & SSH and had the same problem. I just tell my users to logoff with exit and haven't had any problems since (except power failures).

Hi ,

The scenario is as follows :-

AIX version 5 on RS6000
D3 release 7.4.1.RS

Remote login using Cisco VPN and Accuterm telnet.

The user-coldstart includes TRAP DCD EXIT and the account logon proc includes DCD-ON.

Users login with individual aix profiles which include an ap -n command. It appears that despite the above users are not always logged of completely with the result that the next login results in the error message ERROR: PIB nnn is already connected (pid nnnnn) . A subsequent kill nnnnn clears the problem but this option is not available to the remote users.

Can anyone help with an aix script to examine the aix response , and if it is an error to extract the pid and then execute the kill nnnnn before retrying the ap -n command.

Or is there a better solution?
