The long delay/push usually means a monster.

Betting an opponents exact stack means either the nuts or a bluff, depending on the opponent (but there's some consistency in any given opponent)

Betting weird amounts usually means loose aggressive play... watch out when they suddenly try to be inconspicuous.

The limp, call of a raise, insta-push on the flop (stop and go?) usually means an okay hand and occasionally a stone cold bluff.... very very seldom a terrific hand.
